Most automobile policies are written on an Actual Cash Value (ACV) basis. You want your Classic or Collectible Vehicle covered by an Agreed Amount Basis–No deduction for age depreciation at the time of current loss. In fact, Classic of Collectible policies can be increased by 2 percent of vehicle value at the end of each 3 month policy period of time, without increase in the policy cost. F.Y.I. Today's Oils

Approximately three years ago I first started becoming aware of some major changes going on with the gasoline engine motor oils, that are now available to us, in big box stores. We the classic/antique/collectable car owners appear to be left out in the current information cold. My first inclination of this was when folks started telling me that their new cars require synthetic motor oils, and in most cases if these synthetic oils are not used the vehicle's warrantee will be void. By the way, synthetic oil is not seal friendly in older cars.

At the same time, I started hearing horror stories about collectable vehicles having premature engine failures. I was told by a very good sources that the AAI (American Automotive Institute), which is a lobby for the automotive/light truck manufacturing, had the Zinc (ZDDP) removed from common motor oils to protect/extend the life of catalytic converters. This struck me somewhat strange, as I'm only aware of two manufactures, of current vehicles being made, who are having a little oil consumption problem with a few of their models. It also struck me somewhat strange as our old cars, in most cases, do not have catalytic converters & just about every car manufactured prior to 1988 is not subject to pollution testing.

It also struck me somewhat strange that all the major motor oil companies would remove a protection additive

(Zinc-ZDDP) from their oil, which gives additional protection of steel against steel moving parts, especially

under tension. All this done without the EPA & Government getting involved? I'll let you connect the dots.

Some have mentioned to me that STP, Rislone, & few other additive products available contain some Zinc. I, not being a petroleum chemist, have no idea if these additives will

overdo or under do the requirements for my old cars engine. So my next step was to contact several motor oil companies & see what they had to say on the subject. Only one company

gave me a 800 number & I was allowed to talk directly to a specailist. The balance of the information was received via email/mail. These are some of the oils which contain Zinc-ZDDP:

Shell /Quaker State/Pennzoil Corporation;

1) Pennzoil Racing Motor Oil in 25W-50.

Mobil Exxon; 1) Mobil Delvac 1300 Super 15W-40

2) Shell Rotella T 15W40 & 10W30.

Valvoline-Division of Ashland Inc;

1) VR-1 racing motor oil in SAE 30, SAE 40, & SAE 50 weights.

2) VR-1 racing motor oil in 10W-30 & 20W50.
