## **EPA Approves E15 in Gasoline; Ignites Controversy**

The EPA recently approved a higher blend of ethanol for cars, but only those made since 2007. Both automakers and ethanol producers worry the new policy will complicate fueling decisions for consumers. The Environmental Protection Agency recently announced its approval of 15 percent ethanol blended fuel for cars made since 2007. The decision to approve ethanol only for some cars but not others has attracted criticism from both sides of the ethanol debate. Automakers think it's unwise to approve the new blend before testing is complete on older cars. Ethanol producers fear the partial approval will discourage consumers from embracing ethanol blends. The agency's proposed caution label warning car owners that it's illegal to fuel up with E15 on older vehicles does little to calm the controversy.

"Our concern is that approving the use of E15 for vehicles based on model year increases the potential for misfueling," he says. If someone with a car made before 2007 opts for E15 instead of the 10 percent ethanol blend currently sold at most gas stations, they would be breaking federal law and could potentially harm their car. It may not be as bad to fill up with E15 instead of E10 as, say, filling up with diesel when your car takes unleaded, but car makers won't know for sure if E15 is safe for older vehicles until testing is

complete. Until then, automakers would prefer to keep E15 off the markets. The EPA's E15 approval for newer cars is based on a test program conducted by the Department of Energy (DOE). Full useful-life (120,000 miles) testing was performed by the DOE on 19 car and light-duty-truck models made since 2007. The DOE saw "no significant difference" in impact on the fuel systems between E0—gasoline without ethanol—and E15. The DOE is still performing testing on older model vehicles, which is why the EPA held off on announcing a decision of whether to allow E15 for them.
